Waiting is never easy and these months of waiting for our two containers to arrive in Burundi are a test of our faith.



We have been following the progress of our containers as they were offloaded from one ship in India and put on this ship which will eventually end up at the port in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. From there it will travel by road through Tanzania to Burundi.

**We will have over 30 airline tickets to purchase after the PowerPac arrives ON SITE for our planned project dates of July 21—Aug 26.**

Michael Fisher has been assembling the inverter system for the new Young Life camp in Haiti. This will not be a PowerPac installation but rather a pre-assembled system shipped in a container along with many other items requested by Young Life to aid in the construction of their new training center in Maissade, Haiti.

This project is planned for installation early in September, shortly after the team returns from Burundi.



This new Lithium battery will provide at least twice the life cycles and twice the available power daily since it can be drained to 100% instead of standard lead battery's that are only able to be taken to 50%.

Even weighing the difference in cost, this is becoming a huge benefit to the missionaries we serve.
